10:00 – 12:00 – Černohorský močál peatbog - revitalized mountain peatbog and peaty spruce forests; basic information about the Programme of restoration of Šumava wetlands and peatbogs

12:00 – 13:00 – Transfer to the Hučina stream

13:00 – 14:30 – Hučina - revitalized valley peatbog (initially degraded *Pinus rotundata* bog forests and peaty spruce forests) and restoration of a regulated mountain stream (Hučina)

14:30 – 14:45 – Transfer to the Soumarský Most peatbog

14:45 – 16:00 – Soumarský Most - restoration of an industrially mined peatbog

16:00 – 16:30 – Transfer to the accommodation in Loučovice

Evening – dinner, discussions, partner meeting

08:30 – 09:30 – Termination of accommodation

09:30 – 10:00 – Transfer to the Kapličky peatbog
